Parking...Best to park on Adams and Almansor and walk in two blocks on Los Higos

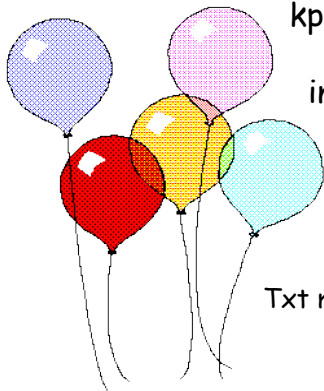
The gated parking near the U12 field will be restricted to the entertainment, referees and coaches playing that day.
